- b) To review the pendency of proposals with the Expert Committee in respect of eligibility of admissions done for academic year 2008-09 and 2009-10.

The Samiti perused the observation and verification report dated 12th October 2009 submitted by the Expert Committee in respect of Health Science Courses i.e. Medical and Dental for the course started during Academic Year 2009-10 on the basis of ASSO-CET-2009 conducted by AMUPMDC.

The observations of the Expert Committee are based on the information provided by the individual Colleges/Institutes. The Expert Committee further stated in its report that it does not physically verify the certificates of individual candidates while preparing this report. A copy of the verification and observation report submitted by Expert Committee is attached herewith for information and ready reference.

(A) The details of the observation, verification done by the Expert Committee in respect of the MBBS course and the decision/direction of the Samiti thereon, are as follows:

1. K.J.Somaiya Medical College, Mumbai (Intake 50)

The College has selected 43 candidates in 85% quota and 5 candidates in vacancy against the NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of 43 candidates in 85% and 5 candidates in vacancy against 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee further observed that the said College has also selected 2 candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 2 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report found no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 43 candidates in 85% and 5 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of K.J. Somaiya Medical College, Mumbai for AY 2009-10.

2. Terana Medical College, Navi Mumbai (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 13 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of 85 candidates in 85% quota and 13 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota. The Expert Committee further observed that the College has also selected 2 candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 2 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 13 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of Terana Medical College, Mumbai for AY 2009-10.

3. Dr. Ulhas Patil Medical College, Jalgaon (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 15 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of 85 candidates in 85% quota and 5 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 15 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of Dr. Ulhas Patil Medical College, Jalgaon for AY 2009-10.

4. Smt. K.Navale Medical College, Pune (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 15 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of 85 candidates in 85% quota. Out of the 15 candidates of vacancy against NRI quota, the category of one candidate – Bongale Amey (SML No.14157) does not match with

ASSO-CET data. Further the Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of remaining 14 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 14 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of Smt. K.Navale Medical College, Pune for AY 2009-10.

5. NDMVP's Medical College, Nashik (Intake 120)

The College has selected 102 candidates in 85% quota and 18 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 102 candidates 85% quota and 18 candidates in vacancy against 15% NRI quota.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 102 candidates in 85% and 18 candidates in vacancy against 15% NRI quota of NDMVP's Medical College, Nashik for AY 2009-10.

6. Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation's Medical College, Ahmednagar (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 15 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 85 candidates in 85% quota and 15 candidates in vacancy against 15% NRI quota.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 15 candidates in vacancy against 15% NRI quota of Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation's Medical College, Ahmednagar for AY 2009-10.

7. PDM Medical College, Amravati (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 7 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 85 candidates in 85% quota and 7 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota. The Expert Committee observed that the said College has also selected 8 candidates in 15% NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 8 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 7 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of PDM Medical College, Amravati for AY 2009-10.

8. MIMER Medical College, Talegaon, Pune (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 14 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 85 candidates and 14 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota. The Expert Committee further observed that the said College has also selected One candidate in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of this one candidate shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 14 candidates in vacancy against 15% NRI quota of MIMER Medical College, Talegaon, Pune for AY 2009-10.

9. MIMER Medical College, Latur (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 14 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 85 candidates and 14 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota. The Expert Committee further observed that the said College has also selected One candidate in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of this one candidate shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 14 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of MIMER Medical College, Latur for AY 2009-10.

10. ACPM Medical College, Dhule (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 15 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 85 candidates and 15 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 15 candidates in vacancy against 15% NRI quota of ACPM Medical College, Dhule for AY 2009-10.

11. NKP Salve Medical College, Nagpur (Intake 150)

The College has selected 127 candidates in 85% quota 9 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of 127 candidates in 85% quota and 8 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota. Since, the Expert Committee found that data of one candidate – Lanjekar Kashmira (College Data: 2900 and MHT-CET Data: 13734) does not match with MHT-CET. The College has to clarify the same.

The Expert Committee further observed that the said College has selected 14 candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 14 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 127 candidates in 85% and 8 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of NKP Salve Medical College, Nagpur for AY 2009-10.

(B) The details of the observation, verification done by the Expert Committee in respect of the Dental course and the decision/direction of the Samiti thereon, are as follows:

1. MGM Dental College, Navi Mumbai (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 2 candidates in vacancy against the NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of

85 candidates in 85% quota and 2 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota. The Expert Committee further observed that the said College has also selected 13 candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 13 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 2 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of MGM Dental College, Navi Mumbai for AY 2009-10.

2. VP Dental College, Sangli (Intake 40)

The College has selected 34 candidates in 85% quota and 6 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 6 candidates in vacancy against the NRI quota.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 34 candidates in 85% and 6 candidates in vacancy against 15% NRI quota of VP Dental College, Sangli for AY 2009-10.

3. MGVM Dental College, Nashik (Intake 100 vacant 10 in NRI quota)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 5 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 5 candidates in vacancy against the NRI quota. The Expert Committee observed that there are 10 seats remained vacant in 15% NRI quota.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 5 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of MGVM Dental College, Nashik for AY 2009-10.

4. CSMSS Dental College, Aurangabad (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 10 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 5 candidates in vacancy against the NRI quota.

The Expert Committee observed that the said College has also selected 5 candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 5 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 10 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of CSMSS Dental College, Aurangabad for AY 2009-10.

5. SD Dental College, Parbhani (Intake 100: vacant 2 in 85%)

The College has selected 83 candidates in 85% quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of 81 candidates, since the data furnished by the College in respect of 2 candidates – viz. Suralkar Radhika and Hemke Amol, does not matching with CET data. The College is directed to comply with the same immediately.

The Expert Committee further observed that the said College has also selected 15 candidates in 15% NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 15 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti. The Expert Committee observed that there are 2 seats remained vacant in 85% quota.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report finds no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 81 candidates in 85% of SD Dental College, Parbhani for AY 2009-10.

6. T. Kore Dental College, Warnanagar, Kolhapur (Intake 60)

The College has selected 51 candidates in 85% quota and 6 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of 51 candidates in 85% and 6 candidates in vacancy against the NRI quota.

The Expert Committee observed that the said College has also selected 3 candidates in its NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 3 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 51 candidates in 85% and 6 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of T. Kore Dental College, Warnanagar, Kolhapur for AY 2009-10.

7. VSPM Dental College, Nagpur (Intake 100 vacant 7 in 85%)

The College has selected 78 candidates in 85% quota. The Expert Committee found that category of one candidate (Belan Haya – SML No.35671) does not match with MHT-CET data and One candidate (Sheikh Shaziya) has not appeared for any CET. The Expert Committee further observed that six (6) candidates have secured less than requisite eligible marks in CET-2009 and they are belongs to the Open category. Except this, the Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of remaining 70 candidates.

The Expert Committee further observed that the said College has also selected 15 candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 15 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti. The Expert Committee observed that there are 7 seats remained vacant in 85% quota.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 70 candidates in 85% quota of VSPM Dental College, Nagpur for AY 2009-10.

8. SMBT Dental College, Sangamner, Ahmednagar (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 12 candidates in vacancy against the 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found that in 85% quota, the category of three (3) candidates (Rajule Poona, Borade Rupali and Navale Priya) does not match with MHT-CET data. Except these, the Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of remaining 82 candidates.

The Expert Committee further observed that the said College has also selected 3 candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 3 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 82 candidates in 85% and 12 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of SMBT Dental College, Sangamner, Ahmednagar for AY 2009-10.

9. PDU Dental College, Solapur (Intake 40)

The College has selected 34 candidates in 85% quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 34 candidates. The Expert Committee observed that the said College has also selected 6 candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 6 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 34 candidates in 85% quota of PDU Dental College, Solapur, for AY 2009-10.

10. VYWS Dental College, Amravati (Intake 50: vacant 7 in 85%)

The College has selected 35 candidates in 85% quota. The Expert Committee found that one candidate – Bakhtar Pragati (SML No. 34084 Category: Open) has secured 82 marks in MHT-CET-2009, which is less than the requisite qualifying marks. Except this, the Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of remaining 34 candidates in 85% quota.

The Expert Committee further observed that the said College has also selected 8 candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 8 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti. The Expert Committee observed that there are 7 seats remained vacant in 85% quota.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 34 candidates in 85% quota of VYWS Dental College, Amravati for AY 2009-10.

11. Jamanlal Goenka Dental College, Akola (Intake 40)

The College has selected 34 candidates in 85% quota and 4 candidates in vacancy against 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 34 candidates in 85% quota and 4 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota. The Expert Committee observed that the said College has also selected 2 candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 2 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 34 candidates in 85% and 4 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of Jamanlal Goenka Dental College, Akola for AY 2009-10.

12. Terana Dental College, Navi Mumbai (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota. The Expert Committee found that the name of one candidate – Ms. Pooja P. Yadav (Asso-CET SML No. 7782 category: OBC) is already appeared and approved in the list of S.D.Dental College, Parabhani (Sr.No. category: NT). Except this, the Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 84 candidates in 85% quota.

The College has also selected 13 candidates in vacancy against 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of remaining 13 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota.

The Expert Committee further observed that the said College has also selected two (2) candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies in selection process of remaining candidates, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 84 candidates in 85% quota and 13 candidates in vacancy against 15% NRI quota of Terana Dental College, Navi Mumbai for AY 2009-10.

13. YMT Dental College, Navi Mumbai (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 13 candidates in vacancy against 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 85 candidates in 85% quota and 13 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota. The Expert Committee observed that the said College has also selected 2 candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 2 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 13 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of YMT Dental College, Navi Mumbai for AY 2009-10.

14. Sinhgad Dental College, Pune (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota and 11 candidates in vacancy against 15% NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 85 candidates in 85% quota and 11 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota. The Expert Committee observed that the said College has also selected 4 candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 4 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 85 candidates in 85% and 11 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of Sinhgad Dental College, Pune for AY 2009-10.

15. ACPM Dental College, Dhule (Intake 100: vacant 9 in 85% and 15 in NRI)

The College has selected 76 candidates in 85% quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 76 candidates in 85% quota. The Expert

Committee observed that there are 9 seats are vacant in 85% and 15 seats in 15% NRI quota.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decided to approve the selection process of 76 candidates in 85% of ACPM Dental College, Dhule for AY 2009-10.

16. YCM Dental College, Ahmednagar (Intake 100)

The College has selected 85 candidates in 85% quota. The Expert Committee found that the data of one candidate – (Shikalgar Jasmine MHT SLM No. 27319) does not match with the MHT-CET data. Except, this, the Expert Committee found no discrepancies in selection process of remaining 84 candidates in 85% quota.

The College has also selected 11 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 11 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota. The Expert Committee observed that the said College has also selected 4 candidates in NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 4 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 84 candidates in 85% and 11 candidates in vacancy against NRI quota of YMC Dental College, Ahmednagar for AY 2009-10.

17. MIDSR Dental College, Latur (Intake 100 vacant 3 in 85% and 11 in 15%)

The College has selected 82 candidates in 85% quota. The Expert Committee found no discrepancy in selection process of these 82 candidates in 85% quota. The Expert Committee observed that the said College has also selected 4 candidates in 15% NRI quota and recommended that the NRI status of these 4 candidates shall have to be verified by the Office of the Samiti. The Expert Committee further observed that there are 3 seats are vacant in 85% and 11 seats in 15% NRI quota.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report stating no discrepancies, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 82 candidates in 85% of MIDSR Dental College, Latur for AY 2009-10.

(C) The Expert Committee further observed and verified the selection process of PG Course in Homoeopathy on the basis of APGH-CET-2008 and also for APGH-CET-2009 for AY 2008-09 and 2009-10 respectively. The details of the observation, verification done by the Expert Committee and the decision/direction of the Samiti thereon, are as follows:

1. JJ Magdum Homoe. Medical College, Kolhapur (Intake 18)

The Expert Committee found that the list of the applicants is not submitted by the College. The College has selected 18 candidates through APGH-CET-2008 in regular quota. All these 18 candidates have secured requisite marks in the said CET. The Expert Committee found no discrepancies in selection process of these 18 candidates for AY 2008-09.

On the basis of the Expert Committee Report, the Samiti decides to approve the selection process of 18 candidates in PG course (regular quota) of JJ Magdum Hom. Medical College, Kolhapur for AY 2008-09.

The Expert Committee further observed that the following Colleges have not submitted the relevant data of APGH-CET-2009 for the admission process in PG course (Homoe.) for AY 2009-10. However, the Expert Committee further stated that it can not verify and observe the selection process for AY 2009-10, the names of the Colleges are as follows:

1. Kakasaheb Mhaske Hom.Medical College, Ahmednagar (AY 2008-09 and AY 2009-10)
2. Foster Hom. Medical College, Aurangabad – for AY 2009-10
3. Dhondumama Sathe Hom. Medical College, Pune - for AY 2009-10
4. JJ Magdum Hom. Medical College, Kolhapur - for AY 2009-10
5. DKMM Hom. Medical College, Aurangabad - for AY 2009-10

(D) The Expert Committee also observed that Sancheti College of Physiotherapy, Pune have not submitted the relevant data of APGP-CET-2009 and Shirodkar Hospital Trust's Institute of Nursing Education – relevant data of APGN-CET-2009 in respect of PG course in Physiotherapy (M.P.Th.) and PG course in Nursing (M.Sc. Nursing) respectively. However, the Expert Committee further stated that it was not possible for them to verify and observe the selection process in respect of the above said Colleges for AY 2009-10

On the basis of above said observations of the Expert Committee, the Samiti directs the aforesaid Colleges to submit the relevant data as mentioned above to the Samiti office at the earliest.

Item No.3.To consider and decide on the following letters/ representations received from individual / Institutions:

- (a) Letter dated 30th September 2009 received from Association of Management of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra, Mumbai requesting to grant permission to admit students on the basis of HSC Science marks for AY 2009-10.
- (b) Letter dated 3rd October 2009 received from Association of Management of Ayurvedic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra, Mumbai requesting to grant permission to admit students on the basis of HSC Science marks for AY 2009-10.

The Samiti perused the requests of the aforesaid Associations vide above referred letters requesting to grant permission to admit the students on the basis of marks obtained in HSC Science (XII std. Science) for filling up the vacant seats in BHMS and BAMS course for AY 2009-10.

In consideration of above, the Samiti decides to approve the request made by the Association of the Managements of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra and Association of Managements of Ayurvedic Medical Colleges of Maharashtra. The Samiti directs that the Associations/Institutes/Colleges to proceed and fill up the vacant seats in FY BHMS and FY BAMS course by inviting the applications from the students who have passed the ASSO-CET-2009 and MHT-CET-2009. However, if any vacancy remains thereafter, then the Samiti permits, in this circumstance, the Homoeopathic and Ayurvedic Medical

Associations/ Colleges/ Institutes to fill up the such vacancies on the basis of HSC Science (XII standard) passed students on inter-se merit in Homoeopathic and Ayurvedic courses as per the basic eligibility prescribed by the respective Central Councils and also the directions issued by the State Government for Constitutional reservations for AY 2009-10.

The Samiti further directs that the said permission is granted only for the Academic Year 2009-10 and the aforesaid Associations and the Colleges/Institutes should not treat this as a precedent for the years to come.

- (c) Letter dated 12th September 2009 received from Ravi Nair Physiotherapy College, Wardha regarding admission of Khadse Swapnaja Sanjay admitted in M.P.Th. course for AY 2007-08.

The Samiti perused the letter dated 12th September 2009 addressed by Ravi Nair Physiotherapy College, Wardha requesting the Samiti to approve the admission of Khadse Swapnaja Sanjay, who was provisionally admitted in M.P.Th. course for Community Medical Sciences in AY 2007-08. Since there was no guide in the said subject, her eligibility is still pending with MUHS. Now, the College has requested to approve her admission because there is change in speciality subject from Community Sciences to Musculoskeletal Science in Physiotherapy course. Considering the request, the Samiti decides to approve the admission of Khadse Swapnaja Sanjay in Musculoskeletal Science in Physiotherapy course of Ravi Nair Physiotherapy College, Wardha for AY 2007-08.

Item No.4. To consider and decide on the complaints received from students/ parents in respect of the ongoing admission process for AY 2009-10.

- (a) Complaint dated 1st October 2009 received from Ms. Forum K. Rach regarding non-allotment of admission in BDS course by MGM Dental College, Navi Mumbai.

The Samiti considered the complaint/ representation letter dated 1st October 2009 received from Ms. Forum K. Rach regarding non allotment of admission in MGM Dental College for FY BDS course for AY 2009-10. The Samiti also heard the said candidate in respect of her above mentioned complaint. The candidate represented that she was denied admission in spit of having more marks in regard to the admission granted to Ms. Chaitali MAKHija by the said College. At the same time, the Samiti called the Principal of the said College to explain the position. It was informed to the College that Ms. Chaitali is a NRI candidate and her admission should be considered in NRI quota and Mr. Kadam, who has given the admission in Open category and got 101 marks in ASSO-CET-2009 can not be justified in view of the fact that Ms. Forum has secured more marks i.e. 108 marks in CET. In the circumstance, the Samiti decides that the admission in FY BDS course should be granted to Ms. Forum on the basis of merit as higher marks in ASSO-CET-2009 than the other candidate. Accordingly, the College is directed to comply with this decision of the Samiti and compliance report be sent to the Samiti office as well as the aforesaid candidate Ms. Forum K. Rach. The Samiti also direct the Maharashtra University of Health Science, Nashik to take note of this decision of the Samiti.

- (b) Complaint dated 19th September 2009 received from Adv. P.S.Deshmukh against Dr. P.D. Memorial Medical College, Amravati, regarding irregularity in admission of NRI and Vacant NRI quota.

The Samiti perused the aforesaid letter dated 19th September 2009 from Adv. P.S. Deshmukh of Amravati regarding irregularity in admission process of Dr. PDM Medical College, Amravati. After deliberations it was decided that the College has to follow the directions issued in WP No. 3509 of 2008 by the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay Bench at Nagpur and also the order issued by the Supreme Court of India on 30th September 2008 while granting the admission process and charging of fees.

It was brought to the notice of the Samiti that the said College has already submitted the list of admitted candidates (through CAP round and admissions at Institute level) for AY 2009-10 and thereupon the Expert Committee, appointed by this Samiti, in its verification and observation report does not found any irregularities in its admission process therefore the Samiti does not found any substance in the contentions made by the applicant Shri P.S.Deshmukh against Dr.PDM Medical College, Amravati.

- (c) Complaint dated 6th October 2009 received from Ms. Pooja P. Yadav regarding return of original documents and fees from Saraswati Dhanwantrari Dental College, Parbhani.

The Samiti considered the complaint dated 6th October 2009 of Ms. Pooja P. Yadav regarding non return of original documents and refund of fee from Saraswati Dhanwantrari Dental College, Parbhani and the Samiti patiently heard Shri Yadav during the meeting. It was stated that the candidate Ms. Pooja Yadav has granted admission in the above said College on the basis of merit in ASSO-CET-2009 through 2nd Round of CAP on 16th August 2009 by AMUPMDC in NT category and the candidate has accordingly reported over the said College. The name of the said candidate has already been approved in the said College at Parbhani. Subsequently, the candidate Ms. Pooja Yadav has granted admission on 30th September 2009 in Terana Dental College, Navi Mumbai without submitting the original documents and formal canceling the admission at S.D.Dental College, Parbhani. However, according to the rule of ASSO-CET-2009, the said candidate has already been admitted in S.D.Dental College Parbhani and the same has already been approved by the Samiti. In this circumstance the admission granted to Ms. Pooja Yadav in Terana Dental College, Navi Mumbai shall not be approved. Therefore the complaint filed by Ms. Pooja Yadav is found to be devoid by merit and prayer contained in the said complaint is rejected.

Item No.5. To consider the following matter with the permission of the Chair.

- (a) To consider and decide on the verification Report on the status of NRI candidates admitted during A.Y. 2008-09 and 2009-10 on the basis of documents / relevant papers submitted by the College/Institutes.

The Samiti perused the Verification Report submitted by the Office on the status of the NRI candidates who have admitted in FY BDS course in academic year 2008-09. On the basis of the documents and other relevant information and other proof furnished by the Institute/College in regard to claim of the candidate as a NRI candidate. The said documents have been verified by the Office and thereafter also checked by the Section Officer. In consideration of the above, the Samiti approves the admissions of the following

Institutes/Colleges, where NRI candidate has been admitted for the AY 2008-09 and AY 2009-10, the details of which are as follows:
